

Research continues to reveal critical information about the usefulness of horses' unique abilities of perception, cognition, memory, and emotions such as pain and fear. Equines are able to perceive, respond to and learn based on the impressions they receive from minimal sensory stimuli as subtle as changes in human body language, biochemistry or vocal intonations; or also from changes in the equine's environment, relationships with other equines, or the equine's general health.

As a result, Horses provide us with numerous opportunities to showcase our strengths, recognize our weaknesses, adapt to change and work with the strengths and weaknesses of others.

AWARENESS
