



Riding at Painted Bar Stables

RIDING THE LOOP AROUND PAINTED BAR STABLES INVOLVES RIDING NEAR ROADS, ON OTHER'S PROPERTY AND NEAR THE BARN, WHERE HORSES WANT TO RUN HOME. PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES IN ORDER TO STAY SAFE AND COURTEOUS TO OUR NEIGHBORS

- **ALWAYS WEAR A HELMET.**
- **YOUR HORSE COMES FIRST!**
Always take your horse's physical and mental condition to mind and do not push them harder or faster than is safe, good for their training, and best for their future. These are your friends, respect will make it a longer lasting relationship.
- **WHEN THE GROUND IS WET AND THE TRAILS ARE SOFT, PLEASE KEEP SLOW AND SAFE.**
You and your horse's safety always come before adrenalin enjoyment.
- **RIDING THROUGH THE CREEK IS ALLOWED, BUT ALWAYS APPROACH THE CREEK FROM ACROSS THE ROAD AND PASS UNDER THE BRIDGE IN ORDER TO AVOID DESTROYING OUR NEIGHBOR'S LAWN.**
During the wet season, please do not cross under the bridge and stay on the south side of the creek.
- **IF OUR NEIGHBORS ARE OUT ENJOYING THEIR PROPERTY, GIVE THEM THEIR SPACE!**
Our neighbors are kind enough to let us ride on their access roads, trails and fields. Please respect their privacy and property rights.
- **DO NOT RIDE ALONE OR WITHOUT SUPERVISION UNLESS YOU HAVE BEEN PRE-APPROVED TO DO SO.**
No riders under the age of 16 are allowed to ride without another rider present.
- **DO NOT RIDE IN THE OUTDOOR ARENA IF IT IS MUDDY.**
Our outdoor arena doubles as a paddock. When we ride there when it is muddy we rip up the grass and cause more and more mud. Let's try to keep it in the best of condition!
